#### WINTER FLYING

As the winter season descends upon us, we want to equip all aviators with the essential knowledge to navigate the challenges of colder weather in the Utah skies. Frosty conditions demand heightened attention to aircraft safety, particularly regarding potential ice formation. Whether you're a seasoned pilot or a student, connect with your Certified Flight Instructor (CFI) to understand winter protocols, including snow removal, de-icing, and the use of 'Carb Heat.'

In addition to these recommendations, it's crucial to use De-Icing Alcohol Sparingly. Utilize the brushes available in the hangar to scrape away excess snow/ice before application, ensuring optimal effectiveness. (Do Not use brushes on wind-screen) This proactive approach not only enhances safety but also contributes to a collective commitment to responsible winter flying.

Winter flying is indeed breathtaking but requires extra vigilance. Stay informed on winter flight guidelines, monitor weather conditions closely, and embrace the beauty of winter skies responsibly. By adopting these practices, we collectively create a safer and more resilient aviation community. Safe flying this winter!


